### Description

This Prize was established in 2000 by Fertility Associates to encourage postgraduate study in health psychology at the University of Auckland.

### Selection process

---

- Nomination is made to the Scholarships Office
- The Prize will be awarded by the University of Auckland Council on the recommendation of the Dean of the Faculty of Medical and Health Sciences

### Regulations

---

1. The Prize will be known as the Fertility Associates Prize.
2. The value of the Prize will be \$500.
3. The Prize will be awarded each year to the student completing the Degree of Master of Health Sciences in Health Psychology or the Master of Health Psychology with the most outstanding all-round performance over the programme as a whole.
4. The Prize will be awarded by the University of Auckland Council on the recommendation of the Dean of the Faculty of Medical and Health Sciences who will have consulted with the programme co-ordinators for the Master of Health Sciences in Health Psychology and the Master of Health Psychology.
5. The University of Auckland Council will not be bound to award the Prize in any year if there is no candidate of sufficient merit.
6. In the event of a tie, the Dean of Faculty of Medical and Health Sciences shall determine, in consultation with Fertility Associates if the Prize may be shared.
7. The University of Auckland Council has the power to amend or vary these regulations, in consultation with Fertility Associates, provided that there is no departure from the main purpose of the Prize.
