The Prize was established in 2005 and is financed by the Department of Psychological Medicine.

The main purpose of the Prize is to recognise the student who achieves the best overall grade in Psychiatry for the MBChB Part V.

### Selection process

---

- Nomination is made to the Scholarships Office
- The Prize will be awarded by the University of Auckland Council on the recommendation of the Head of the Department of Psychological Medicine

### Regulations

---

1. The Prize will be known as the Psychiatry Prize.
2. The value of the Prize will be \$500.
3. The Prize will be awarded annually to the full-time student achieving the best overall grade in Psychiatry for the MBChB Part V.
4. The Prize will be awarded by the University of Auckland Council on the recommendation of the Head of the Department of Psychological Medicine.
5. In the event of a tie, the Head of the School of Medicine will determine if the Prize may be shared.
6. The University of Auckland Council has the power to amend or vary these regulations, in consultation with the donor where appropriate, provided that there is no departure from the main purpose of the Prize.
