At least 75 points (5 courses) must be at Stage III. Major must include at least 45 points (3 courses) at Stage III. At least 30 points (2 courses) of the Languages must be above Stage I. At least 15 points (1 course) of Area Studies must be at Stage III. 		The advice given in this planner is based on the assumption that a pass grade is achieved for all current enrolments.
