The Prince of Asturias Study Abroad Programme in Spain at Universidad de Salamanca 2018 (updated Sept 2018)

In 2018 the Study Abroad Programme will again function through the **Cursos Internacionales** section of the Universidad de Salamanca in Spain. This prestigious university, founded in 1217, is well known for its dedication to teaching Spanish as a foreign language. It offers courses in language, literature and culture to over 150,000 international students. Its Spanish programme is one of the most comprehensive and flexible available. Salamanca, a world heritage site, is centrally located 200 km. north of the capital, Madrid. As Spain's leading university city, it is full of history, art and student activities. It is accessible from Madrid by frequent buses (AutoRes; c/ Fernández Shaw 1, Madrid; tel: 91 902 020052) and train (see RENFE timetable; leaves from Chamartín station, approx. \$30 one way).

Programme: 4 weeks, 3-5 hours per day: 3 hours of language, plus 2 hours of culture or language up to two courses (30 points) of Spanish major/minor at University of Auckland Equivalents: Spanish 277-278 (if passed Spanish 105), Spanish 377-378 (if passed stage 2 or 3) Dates in 2018: 1 Feb.-28 Feb. [You can also study at other times for 2/3/4 weeks or 3 months.] Fees for 2018 in Euros (Note: Always check current exchange rates for approximate cost in NZ\$.)

Registration: €300 (Later subtracted from Tuition fees)

Tuition: 685 (4 weeks x 5 days x 3 hours)

€835 (4 weeks x 5 days x 4 hours) €985 (4 weeks x 5 days x 5 hours)

Includes: enrolment, medical insurance, books & course materials, exams, certification, use of Salamanca Univ. facilities (library and sports/recreation), pick-up and accommodation search (by request), city cultural tours, e-mail account. Note balance of tuition is due 15 days before classes start.

Room/board with family stay. 2018 prices: € 22.00/€24.00 (double/single) Plus

€35 admin. fees (approx. NZ\$55). Optional €14 p.wk. wash & iron.

Room/board in student residence. 2018 prices: €28.25/32.50 (double/single)

Both options include: full board of 3 meals a day and excursion meals.

Enrol online, by (1) filling out application form available online and emailing it back to Cursos Internacionales, and (2) arranging for your bank to send €300 for registration through a bank transfer to the bank account indicated on Cursos Internacionales web site. Email Salamanca to request that they confirm receipt of the bank transfer. **Air travel** is to be arranged by you in New Zealand.
