

DOCTORAL SCHOLARSHIP OPPORTUNITY IN PHYSICAL EDUCATION

A one-time doctoral scholarship is available for an outstanding full-time applicant in the field of physical education.



The successful applicant will undertake a PhD thesis supervised within the Richard Tinning Research Unit (RTRU) that aims to make a positive contribution to the strategic research goals of the unit.

The ideal research focus will build on the international research project: Education for Equitable Health Outcomes – The Promise of School Health and Physical Education (EDUHEALTH), which may include:

- Working alongside teachers to research pedagogical practices for social justice, equity, diversity and inclusion in physical education.
- Investigating the facilitation of professional learning networks and communities that support innovation and change in HPE

ABOUT THE SCHOLARSHIP

- Scholarship valued at \$33,000 p.a. plus compulsory fees for up to 36 months full-time study
- Available to domestic students and domestic fee-paying international students
- Paid work may not exceed 750 hours per 12-month period of scholarship tenure
- Applicants who already have a doctorate are not eligible for consideration
- Closing date for Expressions of Interest: 1 March 2023
- Acceptance into doctoral programme required by 1 June 2023
