

# Regional Rural Admission Scheme (RRAS) Confirmation of Eligibility

## Guidelines for School Letter Submissions

Places in the undergraduate programmes in Bachelor of Medicine and Bachelor of Surgery, Bachelor of Optometry, Bachelor of Medical Imaging (Hons) and the Bachelor of Pharmacy are allocated for students of regional or rural origin. These places ensure equitable access for such students.

Students wishing to apply for one or more of these programmes under the RRAS category must provide the Faculty Student Centre with an official letter from the regional/rural school(s) that they attended.

The letter must include **all** of the following:

- (a) The full legal name and date of birth of the applicant
- (b) The dates and duration of the applicant's study, e.g. "31 January 2014 to 31 November 2018 (Yr9 - 13)"
- (c) The physical location of the education institute, and the name of the local district council

The letter should be **signed by the principal** or nominee, and **emailed by the regional/rural education institution to:**

Letters must be received on or before the application closing date (**1 October**).
