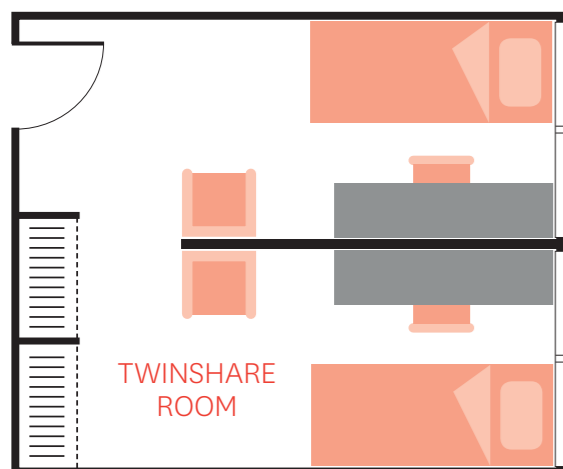
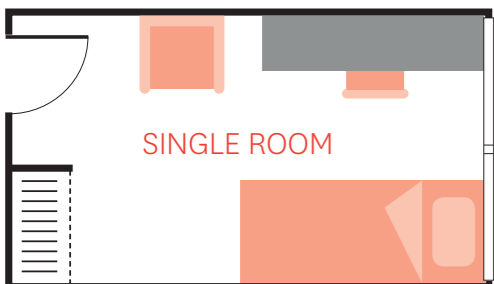




WAIPĀRŪRŪ - WHITAKER BLOCK

BLDG 601-603, 27 WHITAKER PLACE, AUCKLAND



- Houses 168 residents.
- 146 single rooms, 7 twin share rooms and 4 deluxe twin share rooms.
- Security access system.
- Responsible use of alcohol allowed in individual rooms.
- A noise/alcohol ban is in place throughout the residence during examination periods.
- 24/7 reception services operating from Waipārūrū Hall.
- Residential fees include reasonable use of all electricity, heating, gas and water. membership to the University Recreation Centre and access to the University wifi network.



- Single students only, cannot accommodate couples or families.
- This residence is designated to applicants aged 17-25 years.



- Wheelchair access throughout. Several rooms are designed/modified for the mobility impaired.



- Fully furnished study bedrooms, each contains:
- Single room: single bed, wardrobe, desk, chair, noticeboard and towel rail.
 - Twin share room: two single beds, two wardrobes, two desks and chairs, two noticeboards and two towel rails.



- Shared bathrooms on every floor, each contain:
- Lockable showers, toilets and vanity/handbasins.
 - Twinshare Deluxe only: shared ensuite bathroom



- Self-catered residence
- Large shared communal kitchen & dining room. Kitchen is furnished with fridges, ovens, microwaves, toasters and kettles.
 - Optional meal plans are available at an additional cost, with meals served at the neighbouring Waipārūrū Hall during Semester 1 and 2.

Meal Plan A: 19 meals per week

- Breakfast and Lunch: Monday to Friday (5 days)
- Dinner: Monday to Sunday (7 days)
- Brunch: Saturday & Sunday (2 days)

Meal Plan B: 15 meals per week

- Breakfast, Lunch & Dinner: Monday to Friday (5 days)

Meal Plan C: 7 meals per week

- Dinner: Monday to Sunday (7 days)



- Residents provide their own pillow, blankets, linen, and towels.
- Alternatively, linen packs can be purchased through the online accommodation shop before arrival. The pack includes: pillow/pillow case, two sheets, duvet/duvet cover, bath towel, face cloth and a laundry bag.
- Laundry facilities included in your fees.
- Residents are responsible for cleaning their own rooms.
- Bathrooms and communal areas serviced regularly.



- No parking available.



- Lockable bike storage available.



- University wifi internet access available throughout the residence.
- Printer/photocopier facilities available - charges apply. Music practice room available equipped with a piano and one with a drum kit.
- A range of study facilities available, including bookable study/meeting pods.



- Floor common rooms with TVs
- Two games/social lounges in each tower, equipped with a variety of gaming equipment (pool table, foosball table, playstation and classic nintendo consoles).



- University General Library (centre of the city campus) – 8 minute walk
- Grafton Campus – 10 minute walk.
- Newmarket shopping precinct – 20-30 minute walk
- Epsom Campus - 25 minutes by bus.
