

The University of Auckland Entry requirements (Taylors)

Minimum academic and English language entry requirements from the Foundation Studies Certificate to gain guaranteed entry to a degree programme for students applying for entry from July 2020 to end 2021.

Please note: Students who do not enter the University with IELTS 6.5 overall with no band below 6.0 (or equivalent), or English minimum score 75% will be required to study and pass an academic English language course during their first year of study. This course will be included as part of the programme of study.
