

The University of Auckland 2022 Entry Requirements (UP Education)

Minimum academic and English language requirements for guaranteed entrance into undergraduate study from the University of Auckland Certificate in Foundation Studies. Effective for students applying for entry to the University of Auckland in 2022.

Please note that students who do not enter the university with IELTS 6.5 overall with no band below 6.0 (or equivalent), or a minimum English grade B+, will be required to study and pass an academic English language course in their first year of study. This course will be included as part of the programme of study.

To qualify for the University of Auckland Certificate in Foundation Studies, students must pass a minimum of four academic subjects (50% is a pass) and achieve a B Grade or higher in EAP or an IELTS level of at least 6.0 overall with no bands below 5.5.

Entry to the University of Auckland requires the Certificate in Foundation Studies and a minimum aggregate of marks as listed above, and a B Grade or higher in EAP or an IELTS level of at least 6.0 overall with no band less than 5.5.

NOTES:

¹ Faculties with programmes that specify 'Selection' have additional entry requirements such as a portfolio or interview, and entry is subject to faculty approval. The scores listed are alone not sufficient for entry.

² A minimum of one of the following science subjects is required to be passed: Biology, Calculus, Chemistry, Geography, Physics, and Statistics.

³ One year BSc (Biomedical Science) or BHSc, plus five additional years in the MBChB programme if admission is gained.

⁴ One year BSc (Biomedical Science), plus four additional years in the BOptom or BMedImag (Hons) programme if admission is gained.

⁵ One year BSc or BHSc, plus three additional years in the BPharm programme if admission is gained.

⁶ Duration of conjoint programmes varies.
