

Country Specific Guidelines

The information below is based on the more commonly used grading scales in different countries/regions. It is provided only as a guide to the values you should use in the calculator.

Your official academic transcript will contain the grades or marks you obtained. These values must be entered into the calculator, together with the grading scale used at your previous institution.
