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Academic Calendar 2018

1st semester

Academic Period: Early March – Mid July.
Exams: July, 2018
Winter Break: Two weeks on July 2018



Nomination by Partner Universities: until September 1th, 2017 (Through e-mail).

Application Period for students: From August 16 until September 29, 2017.

2nd semester

Academic Period: Late July – early December.

Exams: December, 2018

Summer Vacations: From late December 2018 until late February 2019.

Nomination by partner Universities: Until April 21th, 2018 (Through e-mail)

Application period for students: From March 19th to May 18th, 2018.

Application Procedure to the University of Chile

Language Requirement

The equivalent of 6 semesters of Spanish courses or DELE B1. It is also accepted a certificate issued by the home university, endorsing the applicant's Spanish proficiency.

Application Requirements

1. Most updated Transcript of Records, including approved courses and grades. The Student Mobility Program requires students to have achieved a grade average equal or superior to 5.0 thus far. (Please refer to the Chilean equivalencies of grades)
2. Certificate proving command of Spanish language to at least B1 level, or 6 semester of Spanish language studies. . It is also accepted a certificate issued by the home university, endorsing the applicant's Spanish proficiency.
3. Copy of Passport (Identification page).
4. Motivation Letter, stating the academic and personal interest to perform an exchange at the University of Chile. (In Spanish)
5. Learning agreement **signed and stamped by the home institution.**

The preliminary learning agreement form must be completed according to courses dictated on the previous equivalent semester that the exchange is intended to be performed. Course Restriction

Medicine and Dentistry Faculties are restricted to International Students. Places assignment is subject to academic assessment by both faculties according to courses availability. It is suggested to nominate students corresponding to these areas, with six months in advance.

Studies

Academic workload for International Students

Students must complete from 3 to 4 courses per semester (according to exchange agreements). International students will require to be enrolled on no more than 5 courses. 12 to 20 in-class hours per week are considered as full workload for one semester.

Transcript of Records

Records will be sent to the International Office of each Partner University, four weeks after the end of each semester. For the first semester, they are submitted during August and for the second during January.

Note: Students are required to have achieved an average grade of 5.0 thus far according to the level of exigency at the University of Chile.

Credit System

The Student Mobility Programme conducts the International Students admission into the University of Chile in order to allow them pursuing courses within different faculties and institutes.

All courses undertaken by International Students through the Student Mobility Programme are expressed on credits, according to the table below, which considers the actual attendance or teaching hours solely and associate them to a number of credits for each class/course.
