Language of instruction	English
English language requirements	<p>If English is not your first language, you need to provide evidence regarding your level of English. The British Council IELTS Academic English test and TOEFL are the most common tests, though we are happy to consider other internationally recognised tests. The minimum requirement is as follows:</p> <p>IELTS: 6.5 overall (with no individual component score lower than 5.5) TOEFL iBT: 88 (R=22, L=21, S=23, W=22)</p> <p>If your level of English falls below this, you may be able to take one of the pre-sessional English courses which take place in the summer before enrolment in September.
