Preparation is key, here are some things you should do:

- Research your choice of employers. Such as basic information about the company such as size, organisation, locations, management, their products, and standing in their industry.
- Think about what you need to know about an employer before you make a decision to apply to them for a job.
 - o Prepare a CV
 - o Come to one of our CV and cover letter workshops
 - o Find out more about how to write a great CV – details on www.cdes.auckland.ac.nz
- Dress smartly, first impressions count. It's better to over-dress than under-dress.
- Get a map of the fair (available at the door) and plan to target employers do you want to see first.
- Prepare a brief (30 second) introductory speech about yourself when you approach an employer. Include your name, course of study, stage/year, and career interests, for example.



What should I do at the career fair?

When you arrive at the career fair, refer to your prepared plan and carry it out!

- Gather information from each employer, not just the ones you are particularly interested in. Review the information, your preferences may change.
- When meeting an employer, make eye contact, offer a firm handshake, and show enthusiasm. Ask them the questions you have prepared and deliver your introductory speech.
- Make sure you leave with the employer's materials, answers to your questions, a clear idea of the recruitment process and the name of the representative you spoke to. Ask for their business card - your application may be made stronger by mentioning the name of the person you met.
