

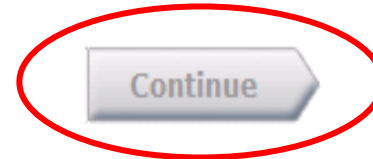

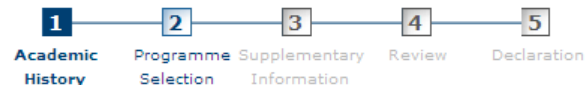

After you apply (1)

You will receive an acknowledgement email from the University. That email will tell you the documentation we require from you in order to complete the processing of your application. This may include:

- 1 colour, passport-style photographs on coloured background (4x5cm), with your full name **PRINTED** on the back of each. This can be emailed through as an image file.
- Copy of travelling passport pages (not identity card or driver's licence) or birth certificate showing your nationality and personal details, certified as a true copy of the original by a lawyer or notary public.
- If applicable (that is, if English is not your first language), original IELTS or TOEFL results, or a copy certified as a true copy of the original by a lawyer or notary public.
- Official academic transcript, in English, showing your current undergraduate and/or postgraduate grades at university, or a copy certified as a true copy by a lawyer or notary public. Do not submit secondary/high school qualifications. **Please include your current enrolment, even if courses are not yet graded if any of the courses in that semester will be prerequisites for the courses you wish to take at Auckland.**
- Course outlines/syllabi, in English, for courses you have studied at your home university that are equivalent to prerequisite requirements for the proposed Auckland courses.
- If you are applying for Stage 2 or 3 Fine Arts courses you must submit a portfolio and written statement. Please contact the International Office for more information.
- **If you are applying through a partner university or agent, please provide all the documents to them instead of sending to The University of Auckland. They can also certify copies as true copies of the originals.**
