## Postgraduate Supplementary Application Form

- Your portfolio must include a minimum of 10, and up to 15 pages of your own drawings and creative works.
- You can choose any page size up to a maximum of A2 to present your work.
- You may display one or multiple images on each page.
- Each digital experiment counts as one page, and must be saved onto a single USB attached to your portfolio.
- All pages must be securely bound and the portfolio should lie flat when open.
- Do not include any loose material.
- Ensure your portfolio can be easily and safely handled. There should be no exposed metal binders, staples or similar fittings. Sheet metal or other heavy or sharp materials must not be used for portfolio covers.

### Section 3: Written Statement

All applicants are required to submit a **one page** statement outlining your reasons for wanting to participate in the MArch(Prof) programme.

### Section 4: Curriculum Vitae (CV)

All applicants are required to submit a brief CV detailing examples of relevant work experience and / or other activities considered pertinent to the application. Details of any academic and / or professional design awards / prizes should also be included.
