Name of Award	Study Area	Criteria Summary
Nunns & Rogan First in Family Scholarships	All faculties	The Scholarships are tenable by students who are citizens or permanent residents of New Zealand who have multi-generational roots in the Far North of New Zealand and who are the first members of their family to attend university.
Ralph and Eve Seelye Undergraduate Scholarships	All faculties	The main purpose of the Scholarships is to assist school leavers from decile 1-3 schools who have the potential to succeed at University and who, because of financial hardship, may not otherwise be able to undertake a university degree.
The University of Auckland Jubilee Awards (Non-School leavers)	All faculties	The main purpose of the Awards is to assist students who are either a) entering the University for the first time and who are not attending high school in the year of application, or b) who have already commenced a degree and are returning for further study.
Lane Capital Scholarships	Full-time enrolment in an undergraduate degree in Architecture, Business and Economics, Engineering or Science at the University of Auckland	The main purpose of the Scholarships is to assist students who, because of financial hardship, may not otherwise be able to undertake a university degree.
Cornwall Cricket Club Crowe Family Scholarship	All faculties	The main purpose of the Scholarship is to support an outstanding all-rounder to undertake undergraduate study at the University of Auckland, to play cricket for the Cornwall Cricket Club and to contribute to both the club and the wider community.

Sanders Memorial Scholarship	All faculties	These scholarships are granted for the benefit of children of members of the Mercantile Marine Service or of the Royal Navy or of the Navy of any Commonwealth country and who are ordinarily resident in the Auckland Provincial Council.
Auckland Centennial Music Festival Scholarship	Music – Classical Performance and Jazz Performance	The Scholarship shall be open to candidates who have qualified by examination or otherwise to enter upon a programme of study for the degree of Bachelor of Music in Classical Performance or Jazz Performance in the year following the year of entry for the Scholarship.
Canterbury Architects' Scholarship	Architecture	To assist students resident within the region of the Canterbury Branch of the New Zealand Institute of Architects, who are New Zealand citizens or permanent residents and enrolled for their first year of study for an undergraduate degree in the School of Architecture at the University of Auckland.
George Turner Wilson Music Trust Scholarships – Junior Awards	Music – pre-tertiary	The Scholarships shall be open to students aged between 15 and 19 years (both inclusive) at the time of examination, who (i) intend to enrol full-time at the School of Music; and (ii) have been accepted for study with an approved member of the staff of the School of Music.
Pears-Britten Scholarship in Singing	Music – Classical Performance	Any student may apply for the Scholarship who has been selected for the first year of a full-time performance programme in the School of Music, University of Auckland, for which the subject of performance is singing.
Swedlund Music Bursary	Music – Classical Performance	Students who have been selected for the first year of a full-time performance course in the School of Music at The University of Auckland, for which the subject of performance is the violoncello.
Taurus Charitable Trust Entry-Level Scholarships in Music	Music – all majors	The main purpose of the Scholarships is to assist school leavers who have the potential to succeed in the School of Music and for whom the financial contribution would make a significant contribution to their financial needs.
The Murray Wren Undergraduate Scholarship in Architecture	Architecture	The purpose of this Scholarship is to encourage and support students undertaking study in Architecture, especially where this funding would make a significant contribution to their financial needs.
