### **Creating an OVERVIEW CHART**


During the next 4 weeks, we will be exploring the issue of type 2 diabetes.




### Creating an OVERVIEW CHART

- 4. Organise your key words under the five headings: The Issue, Biology, Risk Factors, Prevention, Treatment.






5. Put the words that you agree are important to find out about into your overview chart. If you run out of boxes for words, add more.






#### **Peer-to-Peer Review**
