Ever felt a little lost reading a map? How would you cope with making your way from New Zealand to Alaska without a GPS? The Kuaka or Bar-tailed Godwit achieves just that - year after year. What is more amazing is that the juveniles do the journey without their parents who go ahead earlier in the season. Professor Michael Walker leads a research team at the University of Auckland's School of Biological Sciences whose work explains how animals make such journeys. In tomorrow's seminar he will take you on a journey to explain what they have discovered about magnetic sense in animals and how this research can be applied.
