Jo has posted some information about cancer risks for you on the wiki.

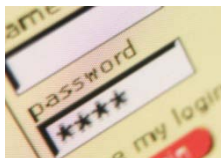
Jo and Jacquie will be checking the wiki and responding to your discussion.
