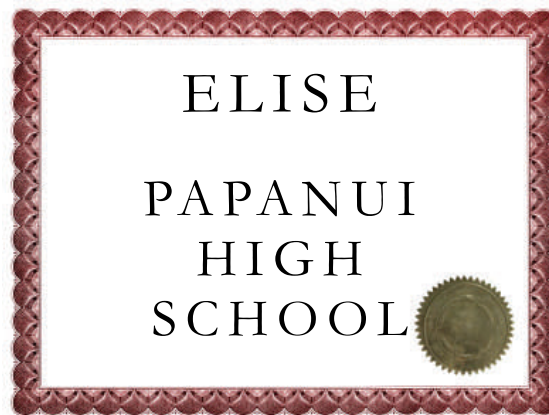

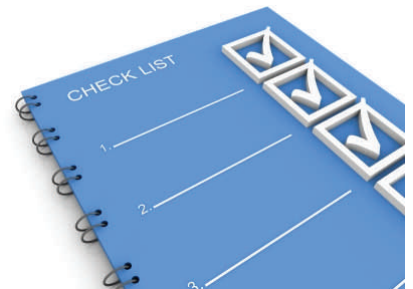
Best Question from Seminar 2
