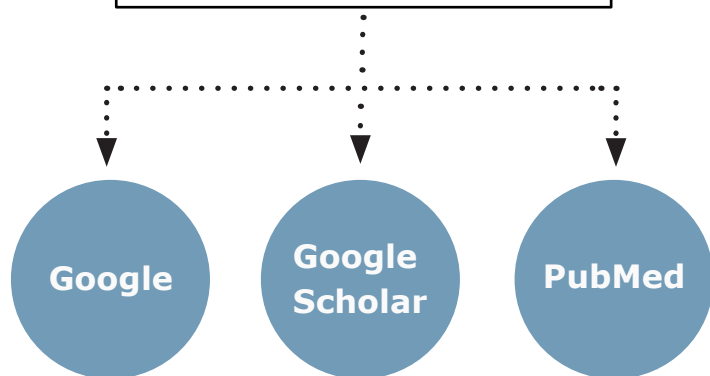


# Get the full text of an article

## ADHB Research Guide



Search for an article title



You can download the full text of some articles via Google or Google Scholar.

PubMed also has full text links in the top right hand corner of an article record. Some of these are open access.

When searching PubMed, look for free full-text articles in PubMed Central in the right hand column of your search results.

Search for the journal title

When you can't download articles this way there are two ways to check whether ADHB subscribes to the e-journal

The Catalogue

**The Catalogue** shows combined ADHB and University of Auckland journals (online and print).

1. From ADHB Library Links, click on The Catalogue
2. Enter a journal title e.g. *New Zealand Medical Journal*
3. Click on Available, then click on the full text link marked (ADHB)

Look for links marked (ADHB). All other links are University of Auckland resources available from a computer in the Philson Library

ADHB Library Links E-journals

From **ADHB Library Links**, click on E-journals, and search for a specific journal title e.g., *New Zealand Medical Journal*

**Note:**

Library associate membership is required for offsite access to ADHB online resources.

Request an article or book

If you still haven't located the article you can place a request. From ADHB Library Links, click on **Request an article or book** to get PDF copies of articles; one article per form; up to 10 articles per week; no direct charge to you or your department.
