

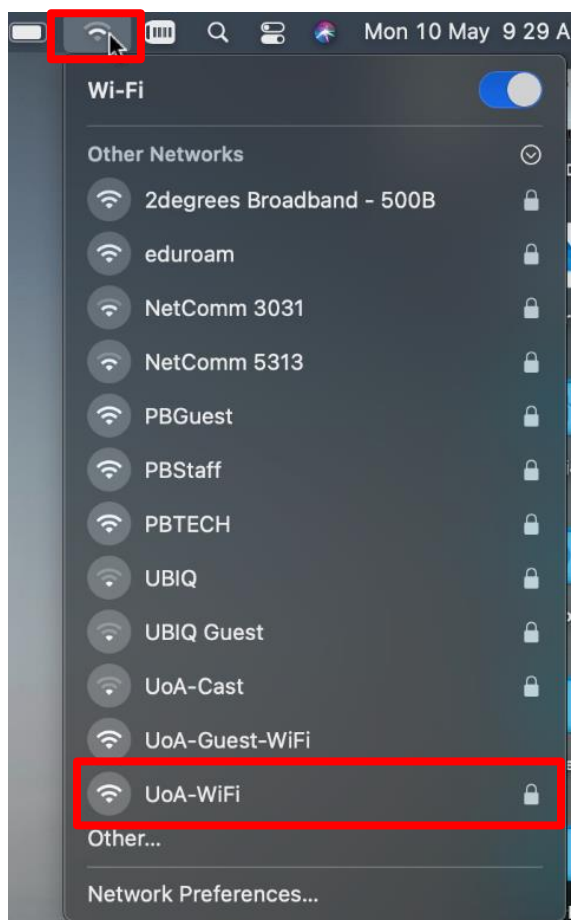
## Wireless network instructions

# Connecting to the UoA-WiFi network – macOS

**Note:** This guide is for use with macOS (Big Sur). Different versions of macOS will likely work in a similar fashion.

## Connecting to UoA-WiFi

Click the **WiFi** icon at the top-right of the menu bar then, click **UoA-WiFi**:



When prompted to log in, enter your University "Username" and "Password" then, click OK:

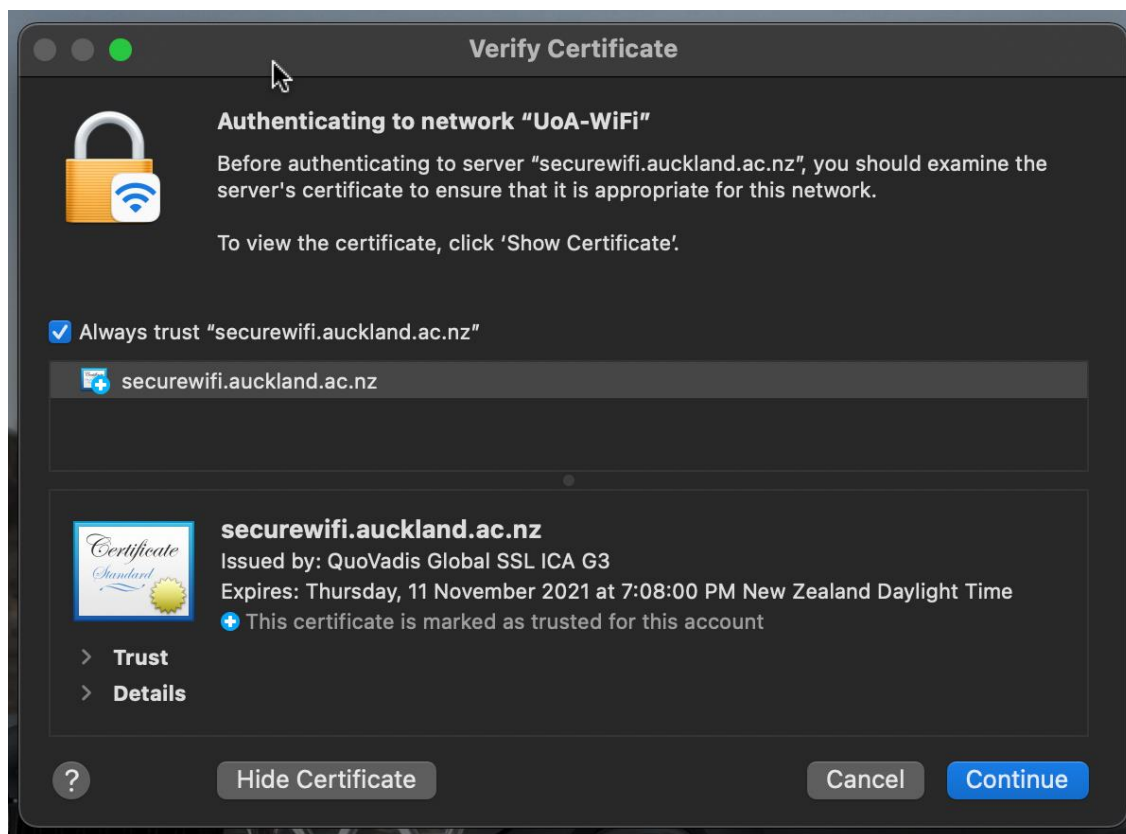


If you also tick "Remember this network", you won't need to enter your login details again when using the UoA-WiFi network.

## Accepting the security certificate

You may be asked if you wish to accept the security certificate. To see details, click on **Show Certificate**:

Check that the certificate is issued from **securewifi.auckland.ac.nz** and the root certificate is from **"QuoVadis Root CA 2 G3"**



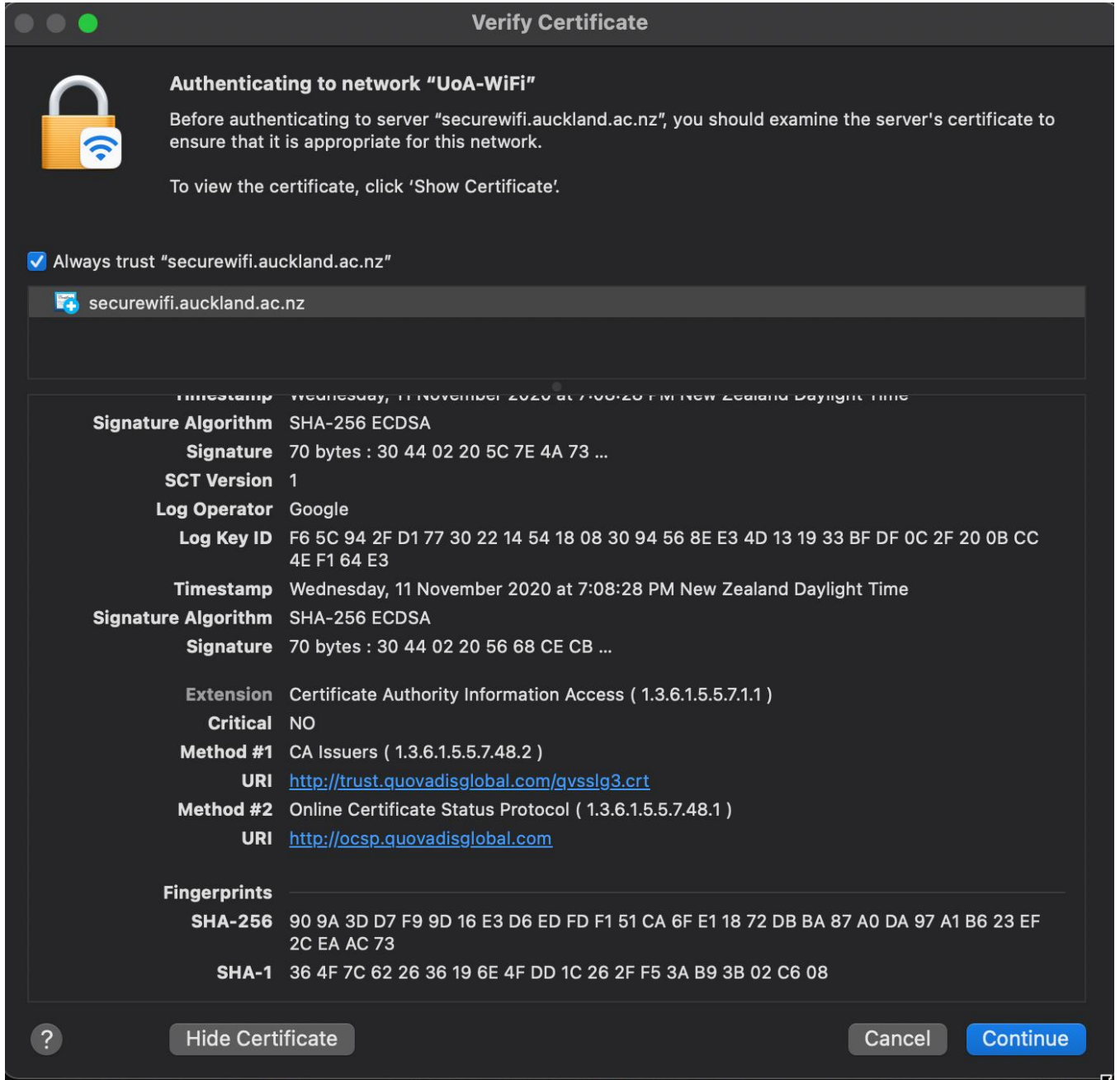
Once confirmed, click on **"Continue"**
