This Fellowship is named after John Kalman, who was a professor of Mathematics at the University of Auckland from 1964 to 1993, and a leading promoter of mathematics in New Zealand.

The Fellowship is generously supported by a grant from the Margaret and John Kalman Charitable Trust.

This prestigious visiting position is awarded each year to an early-career academic to enable them to visit the University of Auckland for a period of several weeks. The Kalman Visiting Fellow would be a faculty member of another University.

The Fellowship is worth NZ\$10,000, and can be spent on travel, accommodation, or other associated expenses.
